Medication Errors Updates

The summary view in the table includes most commonly reported medication errors:

Products	Medication error report	Corrective action
Calcium Gluconate Injection 10% and Calcium Chloride Injection 10%	The packaging of the products is similar in appearance.	The Marketing Authorization Holder (MAH) has redesigned the packaging of Calcium Chloride Injection 10% to feature a distinctly different background, thereby reducing the risk of potential medication errors.
Coufatex Products (1 mg, 2 mg ,2.5 mg,3mg,4 mg, 5 mg ,10 mg)	The mismatch between the tablet color and the strength label color on the packaging can lead to medication errors	The Marketing Authorization Holder (MAH) has redesigned the packaging color scheme to align with the tablet color

**Corrective Action: actions taken by the marketing authorization holder to prevent potential or identified medication errors from occurring in the future.*
